Pvt. William A. Manning, son of W. A. Manning, 2542 Yale, died of wounds received on Iwo Jima, February 21, after serving overseas since last November. He was 20.

Private Manning was born in Memphis and attended Lawler and Treadwell High Schools. He worked for LaRosa Tamale Company a year before enlisting nearly three years ago. He was a Methodist. He also leaves his mother, Mrs. Lillie Stallings of Memphis, and his wife, Mrs. Ann Bowen Manning of Bayonne NJ.
